Dear Parents and Carers,

Further update: possible reopening of school to more pupils in June

I am writing to provide more detail about plans for re-opening for specific year groups from Monday 8th June at the earliest.

We have prepared a video that will hopefully explain these plans in more detail which you will be able to access on Class Dojo or on the school website, or through this link https://youtu.be/y6uHb_ieECw.

All children who are in school will:

- Spend the entirety of their day in a 'bubble' with the same children and adults
- Follow a programme of regular handwashing and hand sanitising throughout the day
- Be in groups of 15 children at the most
- Undertake learning that is adapted to fit within safety parameters in school

It is important to stress to parents from the outset that while we will do our absolute best to socially distance our children throughout the school day, this is going to prove very difficult to enforce, and with the best will in the world it's not something that we can promise to do.

Nursery

Nursery children can attend school for 4 mornings OR 4 afternoons each week on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

They will be in their usual classroom with familiar adults.

We will ask adults to leave their children with a member of the nursery team at the door, rather than come into the building.

Reception, Y1 and Y6

Children in these year groups will attend school for 2 days each week; either Monday and Tuesday OR Thursday and Friday.

There will be staggered start and finish times to minimise the number of people around school at these times.

We will ask adults to leave their children with a member of the staff team at the main gate.

Children will spend lesson time, break time and lunchtime with their 'bubble' of children & adults.

We will not be able to provide Breakfast Club and After School Club for children unless they are in the children of key worker bubble.

Children of Key Workers

Children in this group can attend for up to 5 days each week.

They will be in a bubble with children from a variety of year groups, but they will remain in the same bubble.

This group will continue to be at our hub at King Egbert School until Monday 8th June when it will return to Nether Edge.

Breakfast Club and After School Club will be available for this group on request.

If you are a parent/carer who is listed on the government's key worker list and would like them to attend school please email enquiries@netheredge.sheffield.sch.uk with the name of your child and their class, stating the critical work that you do. We will then contact you to make arrangements.
