

Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 need to isolate.

Individual children needs to isolate.

Child is given a home learning pack saved in W:\StaffShare\Home Learning 2021-2022 (and Chromebook if needed) by the office team, either collected by parents or delivered by school. Work the child completes is uploaded to Dojo and given feedback by the class teacher. **If numbers of children necessitate, time out of class for the teacher is arranged for feedback to be given.**

If the child accesses phonics 1:1 sessions in school, these should continue online.

Phone call is also made each day to the child by the office team. This can determine whether the child is well enough to complete home learning.

Each day at 3.10pm, one class teacher from each year group runs a 15 minute live session on Google Classroom to go through the day's work, praise and look ahead to tomorrow's work.

On day 4 and day 8, the class teacher phones the child to check in with them. Contact is daily by the class teacher for vulnerable children.

More than half a year group are isolating.

Classes are merged. One teacher takes the lead on remote learning (resources, live sessions and feedback) while the other teacher teaches those in school.

Live sessions take place throughout the day according to an age and stage appropriate timetable.
