They learn about to apply paint appropriately.			
Year 1	Autumn Floor Drawing and sculpture Children learn about how artists are often inspired by the environment and can use different tools for creating art.		Still Life Photography, drawing and painting Children learn that still life is the painting or drawing of inanimate objects. They learn about significant artists.	
Year 2	Pumpkin Pots Drawing and sculpture Children learn that artists are often inspired by the environment. They learn how they can use their hands to shape clay.		Portraits Photography, drawing and painting Children learn that portraits are artistic representations of people. They can be created using different methods.	
Year 3	Fossils Drawing and printing Children learn that artists can be inspired by science and nature. They learn how to use print using different techniques.		Barbara Hepworth Sculpture Children learn that sculpting is working materials into 3D form. They learn how sculpture can be made in different ways.	
Year 4	Coil Bowls Drawing and sculpture Children learn that ceramic artwork is created with clay materials. They learn that coiling is a traditional method of creating pottery.		Landscapes Drawing and painting Children learn about great artists who have been inspired by landscapes. They learn about the difference between colour and tone.	
Year 5	A Sheffield Perspective Drawing and watercolour Children learn that perspective is a way of representing 3D objects on a 2D surface. They learn how to create perspective.		Architecture Drawing, painting and sculpture Children learn that architecture is designing and constructing buildings and an architect is someone who oversees this.	
Year 6	Floral Wallpaper Design Drawing Children learn that design in Victorian time was inspired by nature. They learn about William Morris as an influential designer.
