Nursery	<p>Dinosaurs Mini-beasts Nativity Routines & Family Conversations</p> <p>Children learn about the chronology of time because dinosaurs lived a long time ago. They learn about how things change over time (e.g. caterpillar to butterfly). Children learn the story of the Nativity happened in the past. They learn about how people grow and change over time.</p>			
Reception	<p>Mini-beasts Communication Me and My World</p> <p>Children learn how living things change over time. They learn about the ways people communicated in the past and how this has changed over time. Children begin to develop an understanding of significant events in the past. They reflect on how they have changed in reception.</p>			
Year 1	<p>Toys Through Time Children learn that toys have changed over time and some toys in the past were unsafe in comparison with toys today.</p>		<p>The Moon Landings Children learn that moon landings were in 1969. They learn that America won the space race.</p>	
Year 2	<p>The Great Fire of London Children learn the events of the great fire in 1666. They learn about key figures involved.</p>		<p>Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole Children learn about the adversities faced by Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole. They learn about their significance in British society.</p>	
Year 3	<p>Stone to Iron Age Children learn that the earliest settlers were hunter gatherers. They learn about the importance of farming.</p>		<p>The Romans in Britain Children learn about why the Romans invaded Britain, the significance of Boudicca, the legacy of Roman occupation in Britain and why they left.</p>	
Year 4	<p>Anglo-Saxon Britain Children learn there was little evidence left behind by the Anglo-Saxons, about push/pull factors, the coming of Christianity and the achievement of Alfred the Great.</p>		<p>The Vikings in Britain Children learn about where the Vikings came from and why they attacked, the importance of longships, Viking Gods and the reputation of the Vikings as raiders, traders and explorers.</p>	
Year 5	<p>Ancient Egypt Children learn about the hierarchy of Egyptian society, the pyramids, travel and trade, their belief system and the discovery Tutankhamun's tomb.</p>		<p>Early Islam and Baghdad Children learn about the establishment of the first Islamic Caliphate, life in 900CE Baghdad, the House of Wisdom, the Silk Roads and comparisons between Dark Age London and Golden Age Baghdad.</p>	
Year 6	<p>WWII Britain Children learn about why Britain went to war, the effects of WWII in Britain, the experiences of evacuee children, the role women played in the war and the legacy of the Women of Steel in Sheffield.</p>		<p>The Industrial Revolution in Victorian Britain Children learn about key inventions and people from the Industrial Revolution, the class structure of Britain, housing, the lives of children and how the Industrial Revolution changed Sheffield.</p>	



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
